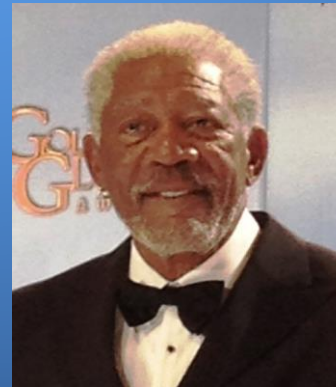
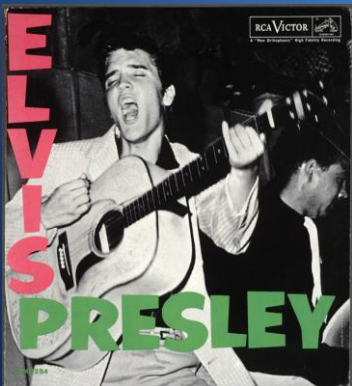
Mississippi At-A-Glance

# Mississippi -- A Great Place to Live

# Mississippi College History

- ★ On December 18, 1830, having become a college, MC's name was changed from Mississippi Academy to Mississippi College. It offered degrees in arts, sciences and languages. Now MC offers 80 undergraduate majors and 50 graduate majors across all disciplines
- ★ As a private institution in 1831, Mississippi College became the first coeducational college in the United States to award a degree to a female student
- ★ Mississippi is a 4-year comprehensive university which offers extensive undergraduate and graduate programs. MC did not change its name to “university” in order to keep its tradition

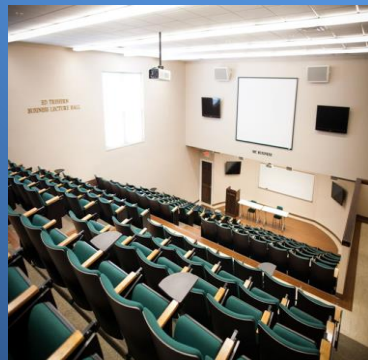

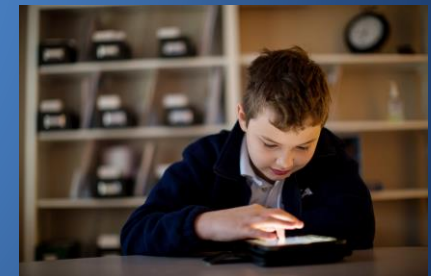

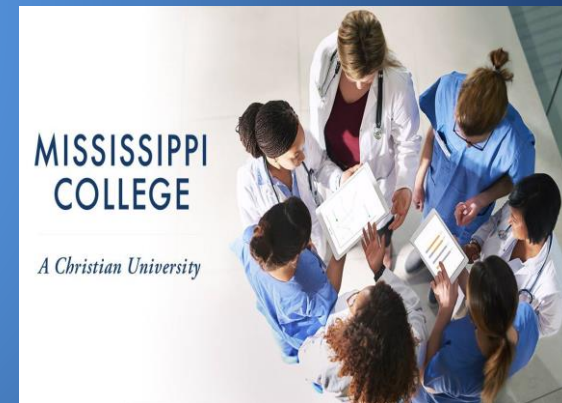

## *Tuition & Fees*

Mississippi College is ranked as one of the BEST VALUE universities in the U.S. because of its low tuition, affordable cost of living, and high quality instruction. The tuition and fees for two academic semesters for undergraduate and graduate are as follows:

# AFFORDABLE!!

## Scholarships

### Undergraduate

- ★ Incoming international undergraduate students receive **\$2000/semester** in scholarship for their first two semesters of academic study as long as the students maintain a 2.5 GPA or above. This amount is increased to **\$3000/semester or higher** if the student receives all A's in the previous semester.
- ★ Other scholarships may be available to athletes, students learning English, or students with exceptional test scores (ACT, SAT, etc.)

### Graduate

- ★ Incoming international graduate students receive **\$1500/semester** in scholarship. This amount is increased to **\$2000/semester or higher** if the student receives all A's the previous semester.

# Application Process

★ **Fill out the online application** and **submit the application fee** at:

★ **Required documents:**

**Undergraduate applicants:** High school transcript, high school diploma, bank statement, language proficiency scores (IELTS 5.5 or TOEFL 69) & GPA 2.5.

**Graduate applicants:** Undergraduate transcript, undergraduate diploma, 3 letters of recommendation, a personal statement, bank statement, language proficiency scores (IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL 79) & GPA 2.5. GRE/GMAT is not required to apply. ***Some (not all) graduate programs may require a GRE/GMAT score to apply when an applicant's GPA is below 3.0.***

***Due to Covid-19 pandemic GRE & GMAT are waived for the 2020 fall and 2021 spring semesters intake.***

**Notes:** Students who do not have an IELTS or TOEFL score can be admitted to our Intensive English Program (IEP) and may be required to take English language classes at the IEP before being admitted to an academic program.

***Due to Covid-19 pandemic, international students are allowed to take Duolingo as an alternative language proficiency test.***
