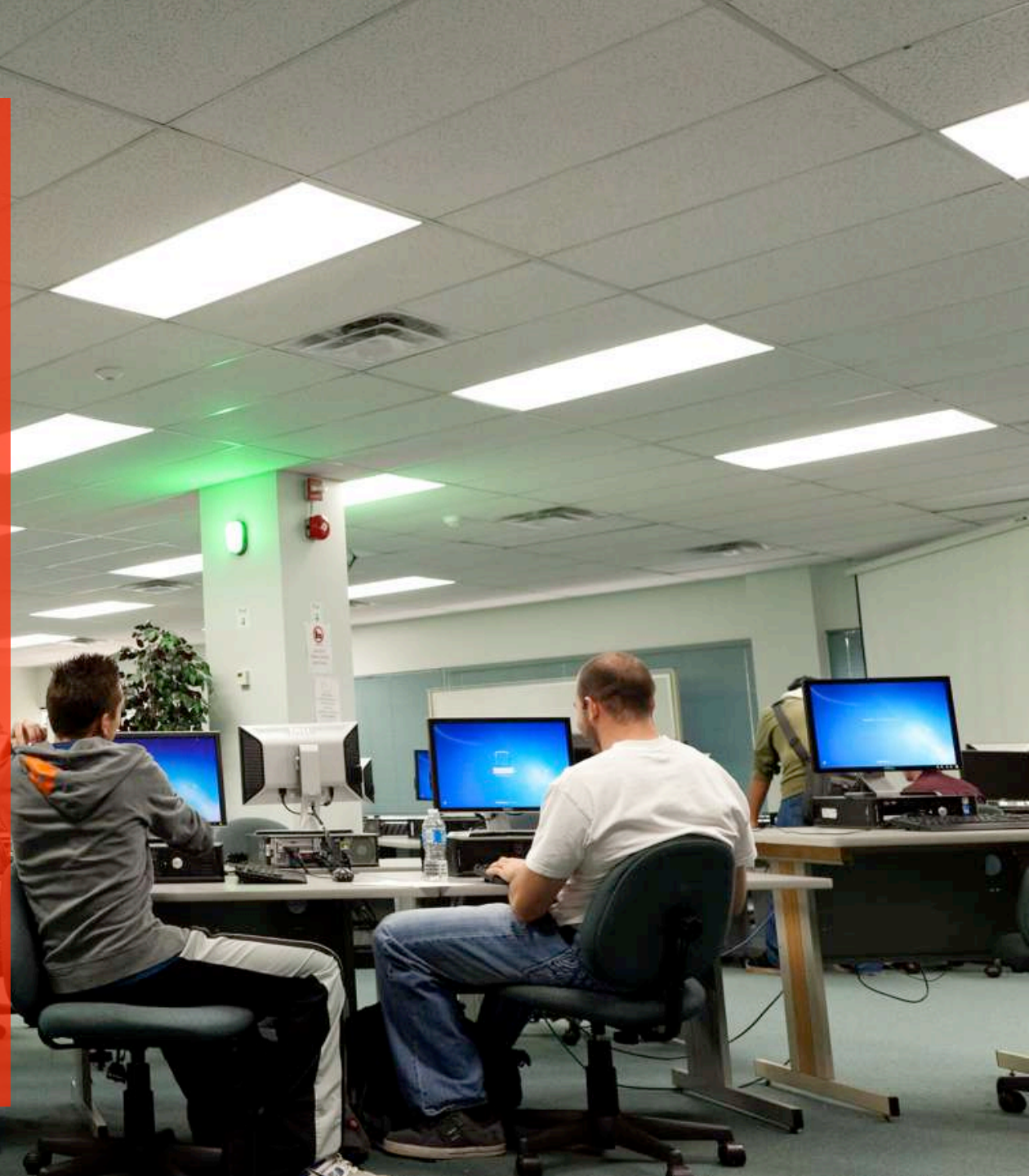
## LIFE AFTER GRADUATION

- Study for less than 2 years ➤ May work in Canada for as long as your program lasted after graduation
- Study for 2 years or more ➤ May work in Canada for up to 3 years after graduation
- Work in Canada for min. 1 year (1560h) after graduation ➤ May apply for Permanent Residency in Canada
- Permanent Residents may eventually qualify for Canadian citizenship

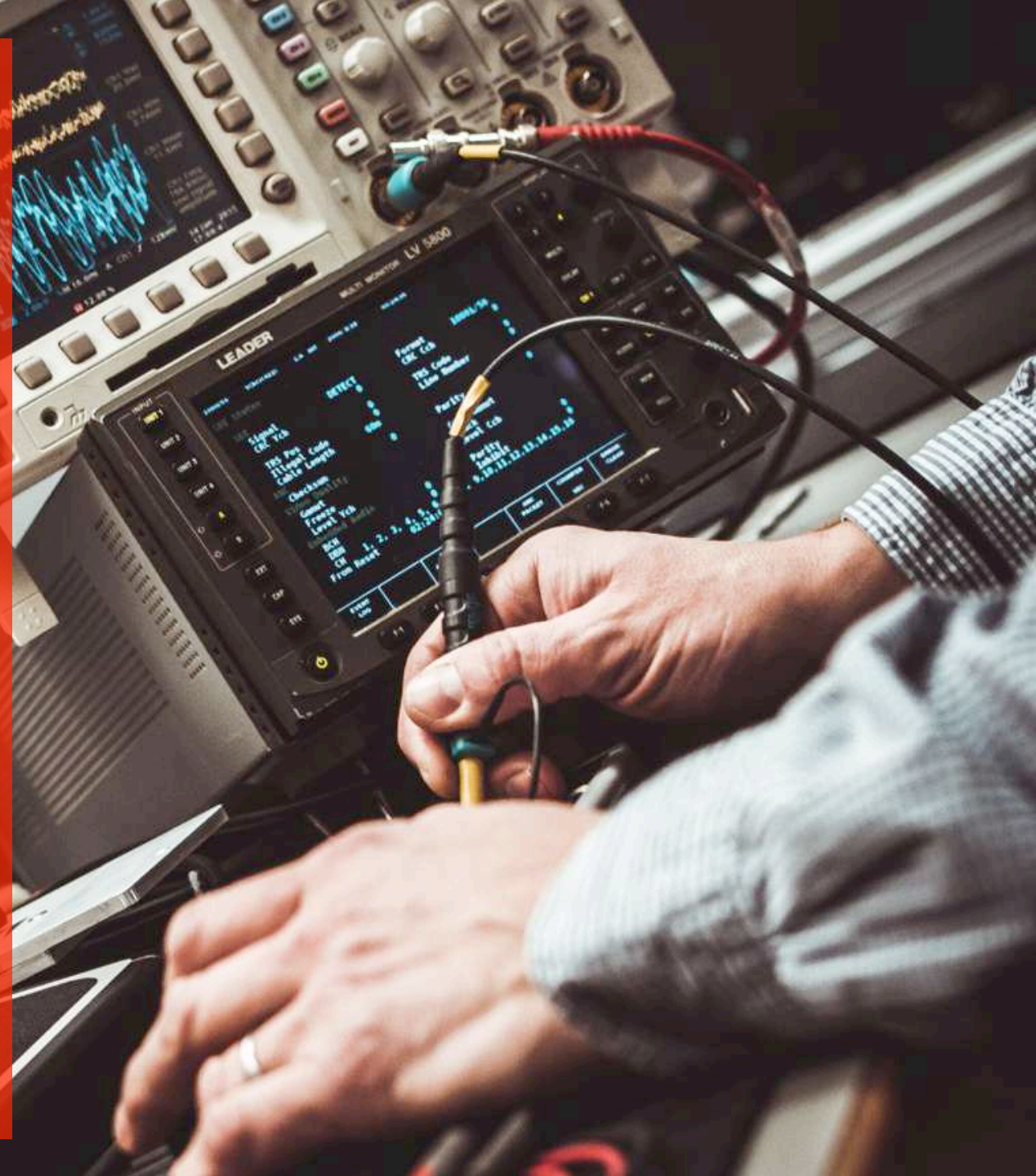



- \$100 Application fee
- Valid passport
- Proof of English proficiency (IELTS Academic)





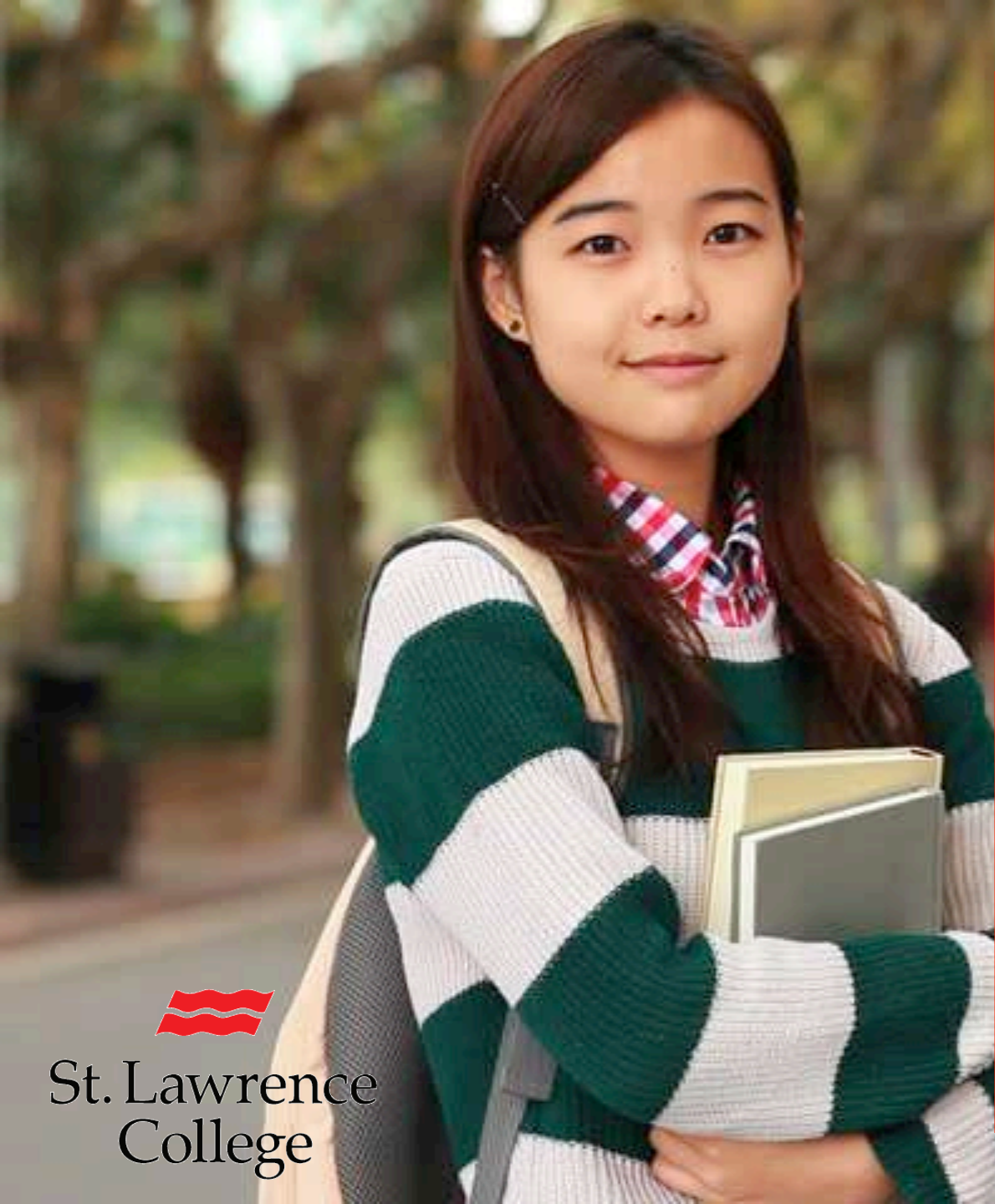

## TUITION AND EXPENSES
