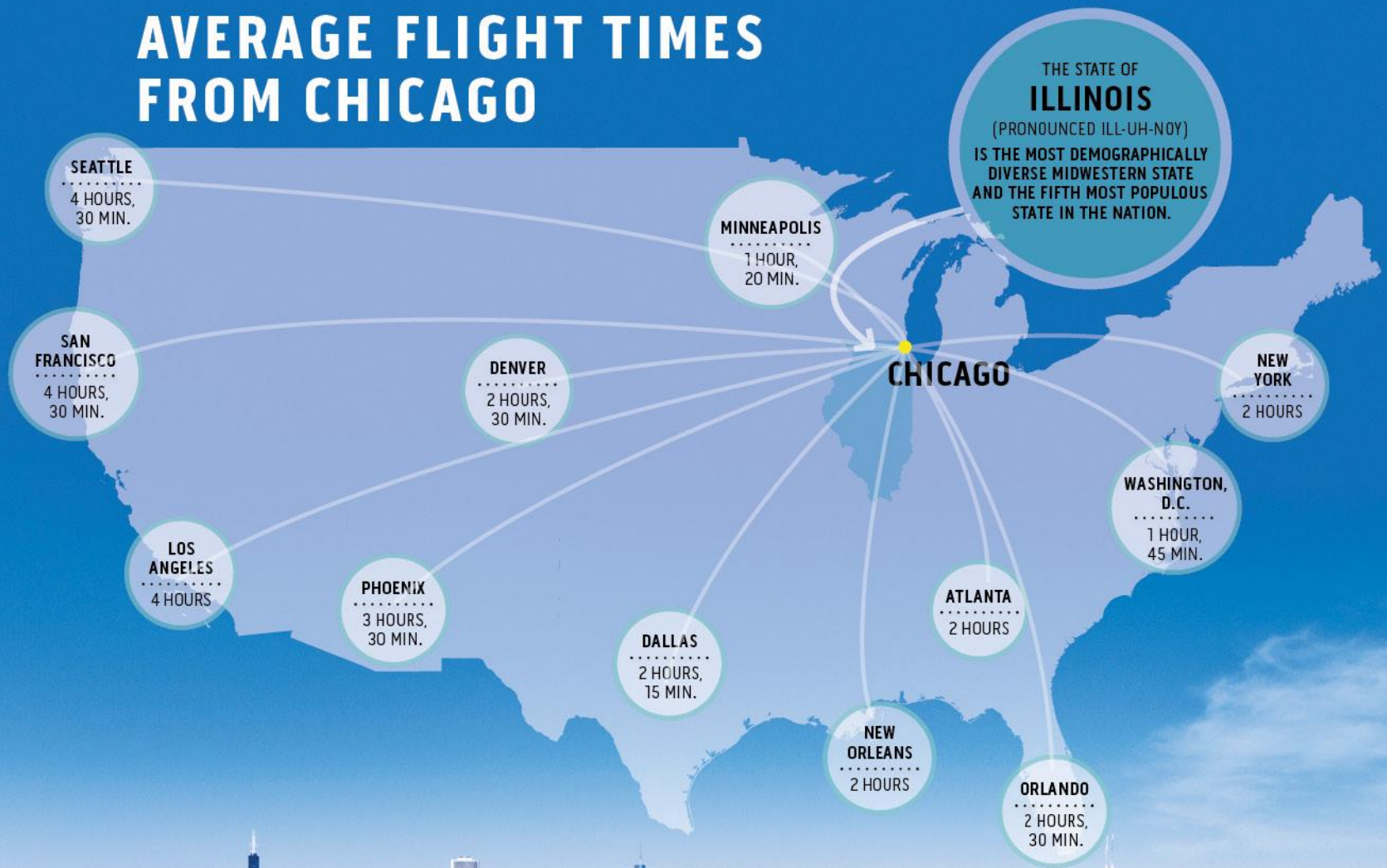

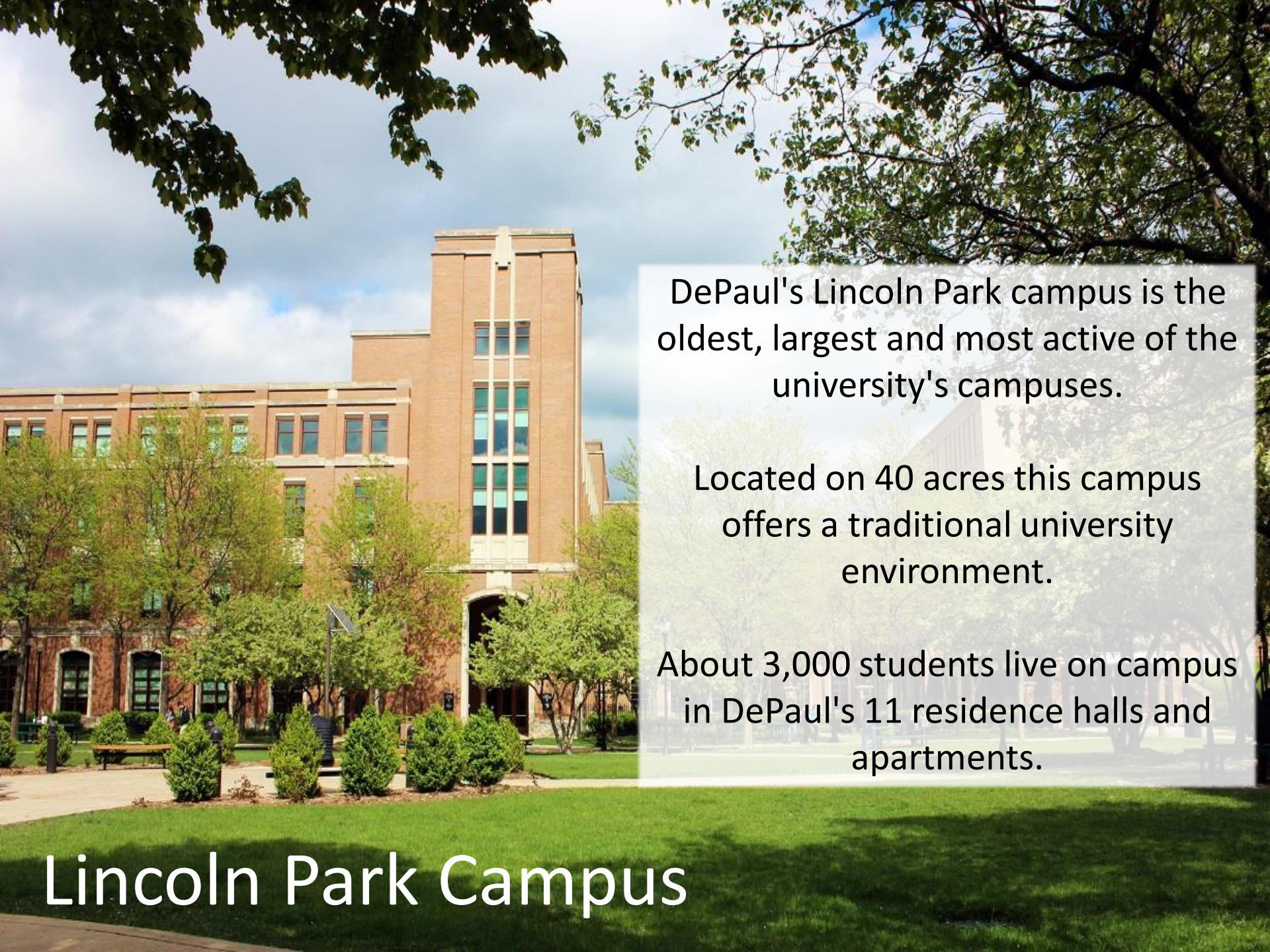

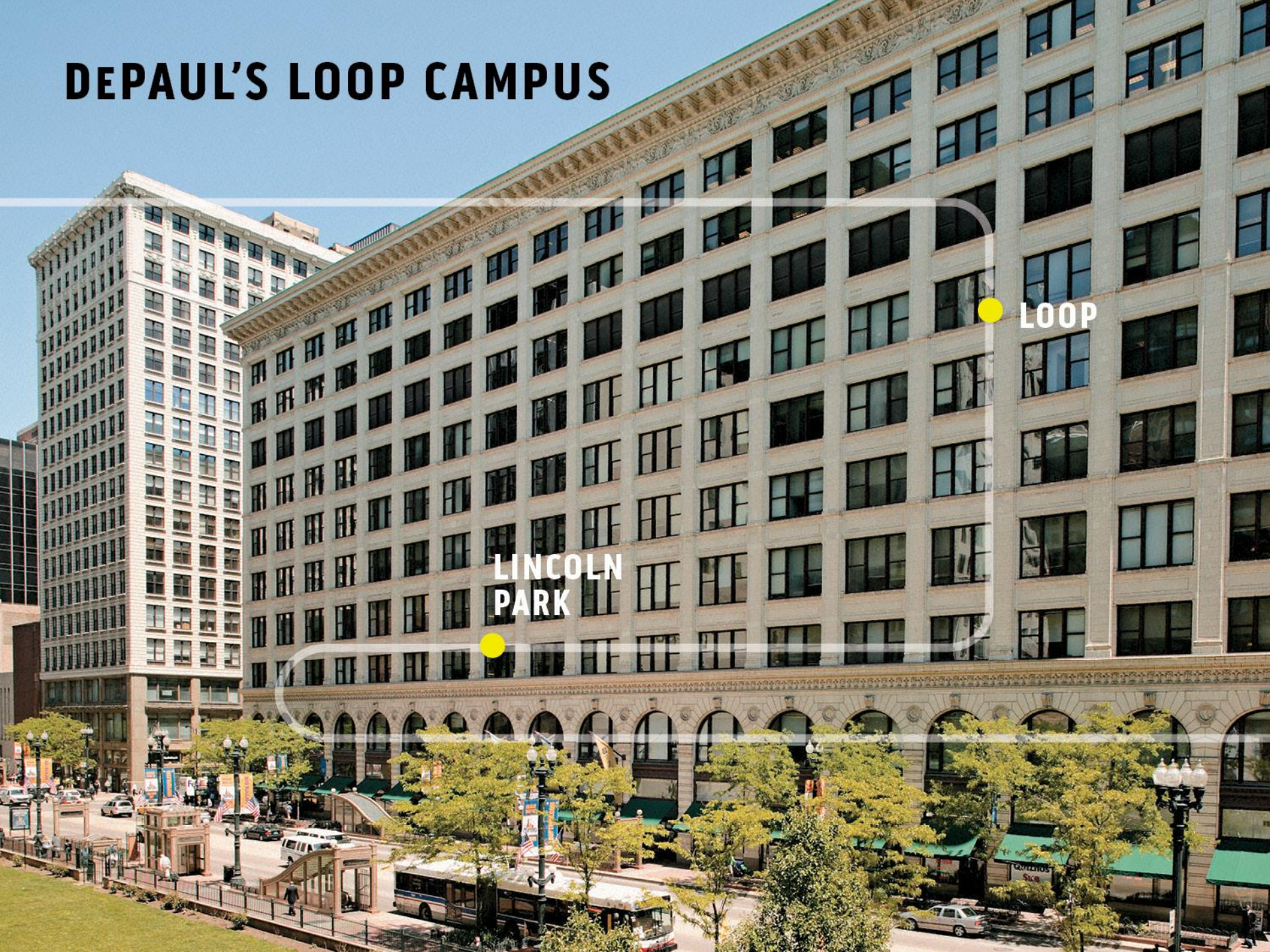
DePaul's Lincoln Park campus is the oldest, largest and most active of the university's campuses.

About 3,000 students live on campus in DePaul's 11 residence halls and apartments.



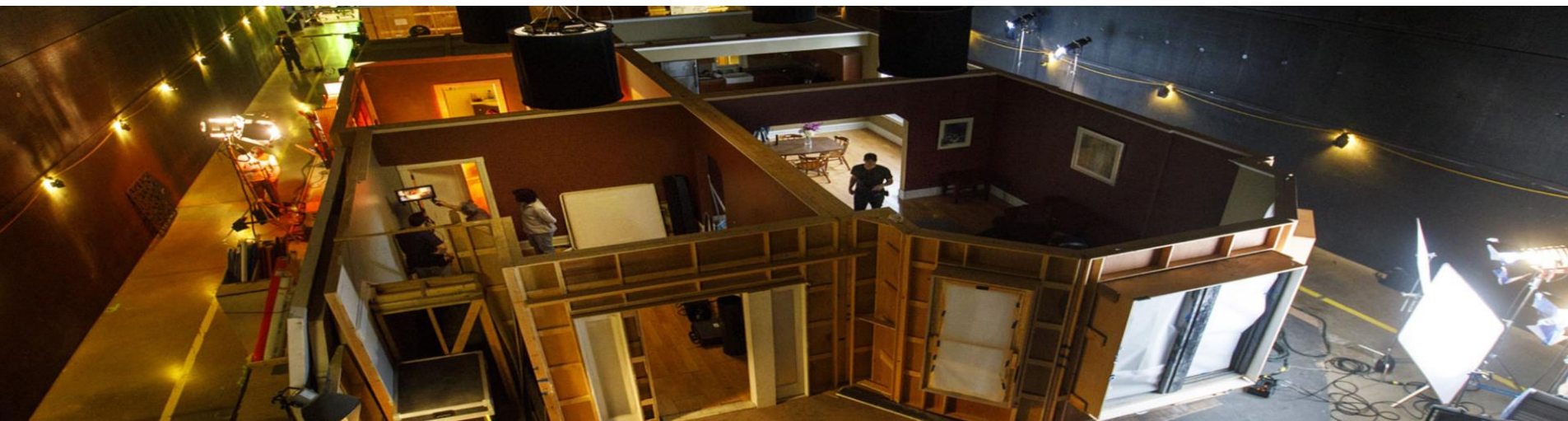

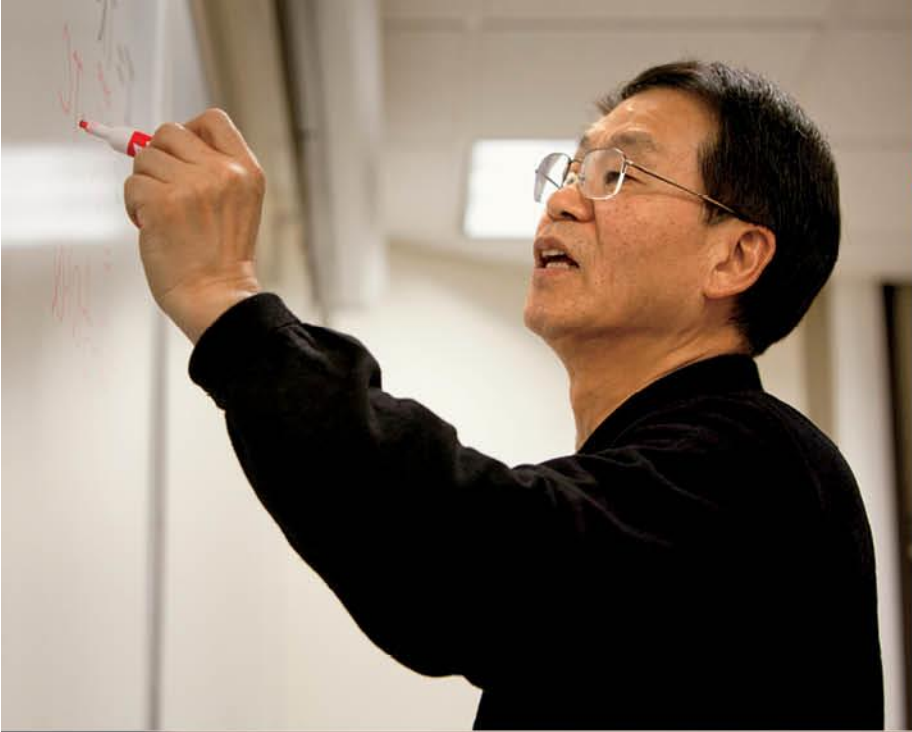

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

Undergraduate Admission

- Apply Online via Common Application – *No Application Fee!*
 - Apply by Nov 15 for Early Action & Feb 1 for Regular Notification*
- Submit Official High School Transcripts and English Translations
- **Transfer Applicants Only:** Official U.S. College/University Transcripts or Course-by-Course Evaluation for International University Transcripts
 - Educational Perspectives
 - Educational Credential Evaluators
 - One Earth International Credential Evaluations
- Submit English Proficiency (students need to submit only **one** of the following):
 - iBT TOEFL: minimum score of 80, no section lower than 17
 - IELTS Academic: minimum score of 6.5 overall
 - ACT: minimum reading score of 18 and English score of 20
 - SAT: minimum EBRW score of 540
 - **DET (Duolingo):** minimum score of 110
 - Conditional admission is offered
