





UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

Undergraduate Admission

- Apply Online via Common Application *No Application Fee!*
 - Apply by Nov 15 for Early Action & Feb 1 for Regular Notification*
- Submit Official High School Transcripts and English Translations
- **Transfer Applicants Only**: Official U.S. College/University Transcripts or Course-by-Course Evaluation for International University Transcripts
 - Educational Perspectives
 - Educational Credential Evaluators
 - One Earth International Credential Evaluations
- Submit English Proficiency (students need to submit only **one** of the following):
 - iBT TOEFL: minimum score of 80, no section lower than 17
 - IELTS Academic: minimum score of 6.5 overall
 - ACT: minimum reading score of 18 and English score of 20
 - SAT: minimum EBRW score of 540
 - **DET (Duolingo)**: minimum score of 110
 - Conditional admission is offered
