





APPLICATION: GRADUATE



Application requirements:

- Online application
- Complete transcripts
- Evidence of English Language Proficiency
- GRE/GMAT (if applicable)
- Letters of Recommendation
- Resume
- Essay/Statement of Purpose
- Financial documentation not required at time of application
- No application fee!

Three year bachelor degrees are accepted for all graduate programs!

Conditional admission is available for graduate programs in:

- The College of Architecture & Planning
- The College of Engineering, Design, and Computing
- The School of Education & Human Development

APPLICATION: GRADUATE



Graduate Application Tips:

- All departments make holistic admission decisions
 The department looks at applicants as a whole, and wants to see a well-rounded application.
- Most programs don't have a set GPA minimum, but 3.0 is a good guideline
- Backlogs: no set maximum; varies by program
 - Computer Science: no more than 2
 - Other Engineering programs: no more than 3-4
- A good Statement of Purpose can make or break the application. The department wants to get to know YOU, why you are interested in the program, how you will contribute to the department, and how the degree will help your future career.
- Test scores and GPA are not everything
- Work experience is not a requirement for any program, but it can definitely help!
- PhD Applicants: it is recommended to make contact with the department before applying and make sure your research matches the work of the department.

GRE or GMAT is required for all programs in the Business School.

Programs do **not have set GRE minimums,**but 50th percentile or above is a good guideline.


Graduate applicants will receive a decision within 4-6 weeks of the point at which we receive a complete application.
