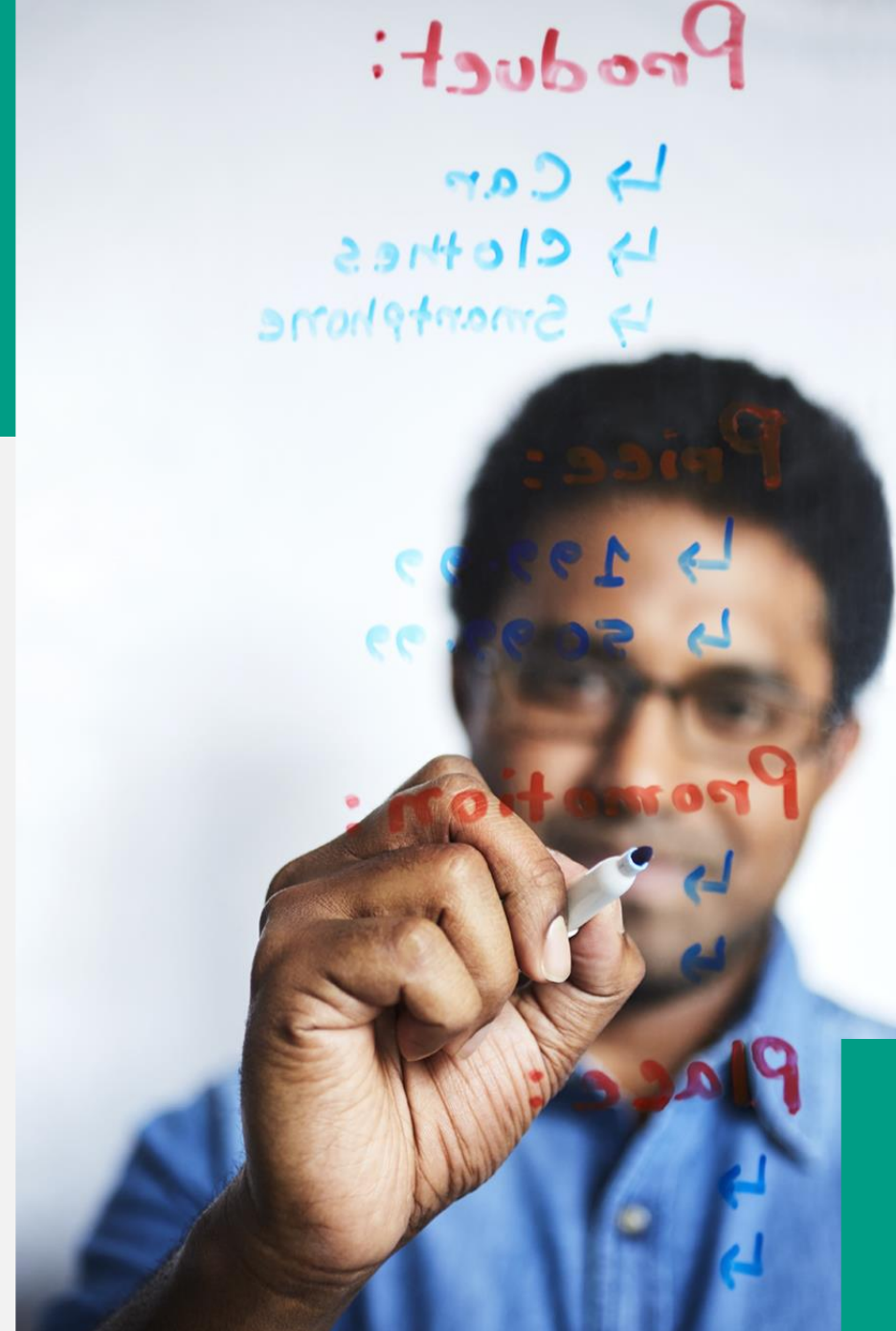

- Faculty NEED Research Assistants!
 - Paid & Volunteer Assistants
 - Published in academic journals graduation
 - Presenters at academic conferences

CO-OPERATIVE EDUCATION (INTERNSHIP)

- Paid Canadian work experience
- Full-time, four month placements - 35 hours/week
- Minimum wage in Ontario \$14 CDN/hour – approx. \$11 US/hour

POST-GRADUATION

- Three-year, open work permit
- Can qualify after completing a Canadian degree

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

“AS” Level Admission

Minimum four “AS” level subjects are required for admission with a grade of A*, A, B, or C.

“A” Level Admission

Minimum two “A” level subjects are required for admission with a grade of A*, A, B, or C.

Bachelor of Science & any Business related programs require specific courses.

ADVANCED STANDING

Students presenting the **General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (“A” Levels)** can earn advanced standing for **“A2”** level courses with an A, B or C grade.

Each course is considered equivalent to two courses at Algoma U. Students can earn a maximum of 10 courses.

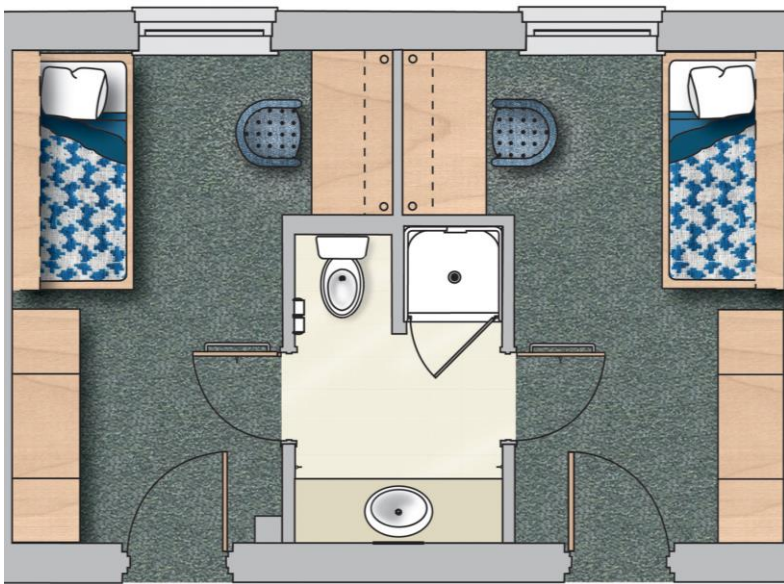
