## Awards and Bursaries

### **Schulich Scholarship**

- \$7,000 CAD
- Awarded to selected full-time students entering the first year of an undergraduate degree program with a focus on education
- Concurrent Education, Bachelor of Physical and Health Education, or the Consecutive Bachelor of Education
  - Students applying to the 2 year Consecutive Bachelor of Education program should apply for the Schulich Scholarship by January 15, 2020
- Must have a minimum of 80% average and at least one of the following: volunteer work; community involvement; or financial need.

# Admissions

### International Baccalaureate Transfer Policy
