






# CO-OP vs PRACTICUM

A practicum is a REQUIRED part of a program (must finish)

Length	Fall Semester	Winter Semester	May to October
Year 1	Study	Study	5 month Practicum
Year 2	Study	Study	April Graduation

- A practicum MAY be paid or unpaid
- > A practicum is sometimes called a WORK TERM
- A co-op is an **OPTIONAL** part of a program
- A co-op is PAID work experience in your field of study
- A co-op placement is not guaranteed and enrolment in the program is often based on grades and instructor recommendations


Co-op receive credit on transcripts and require final reports and regular online submissions


