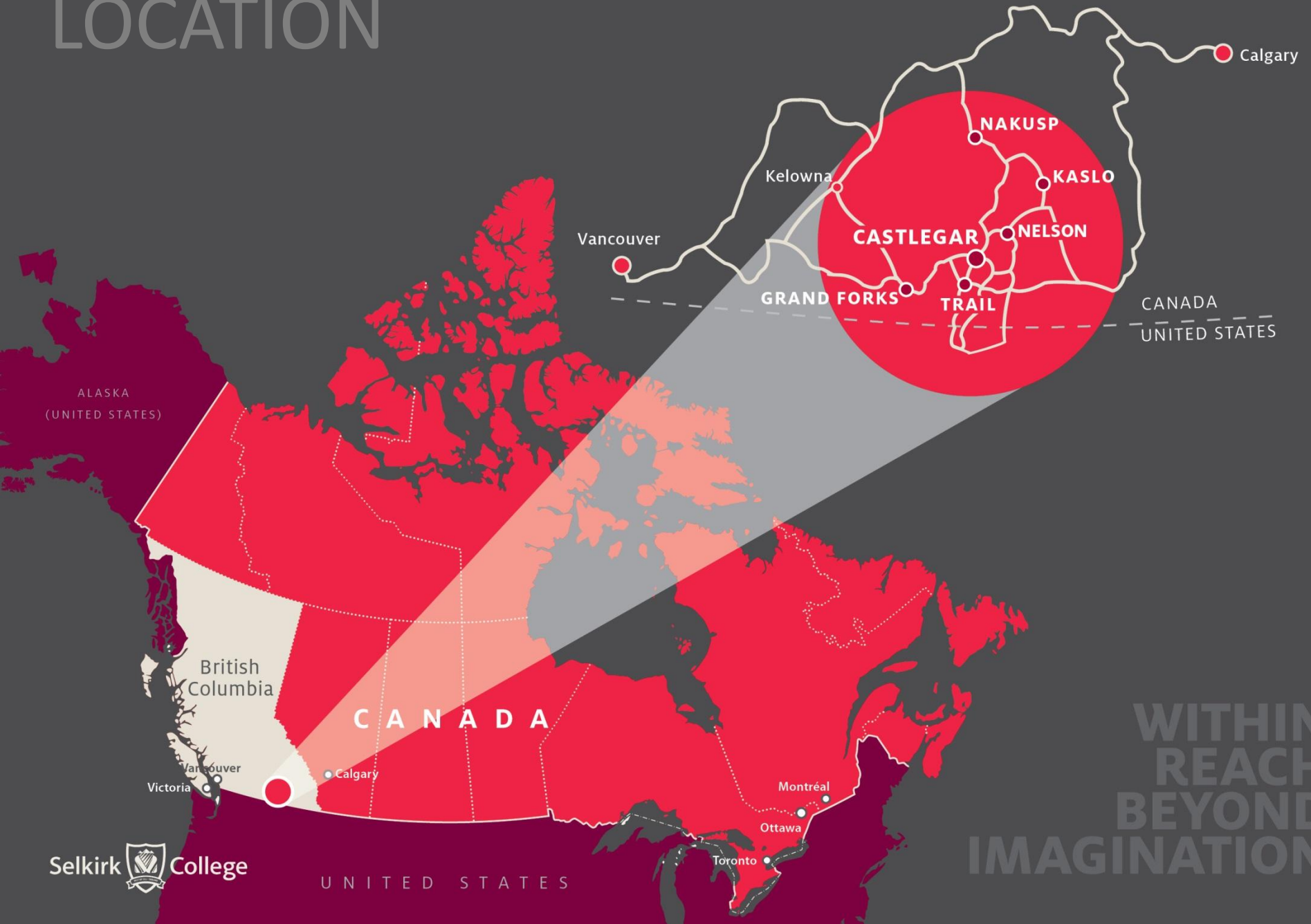

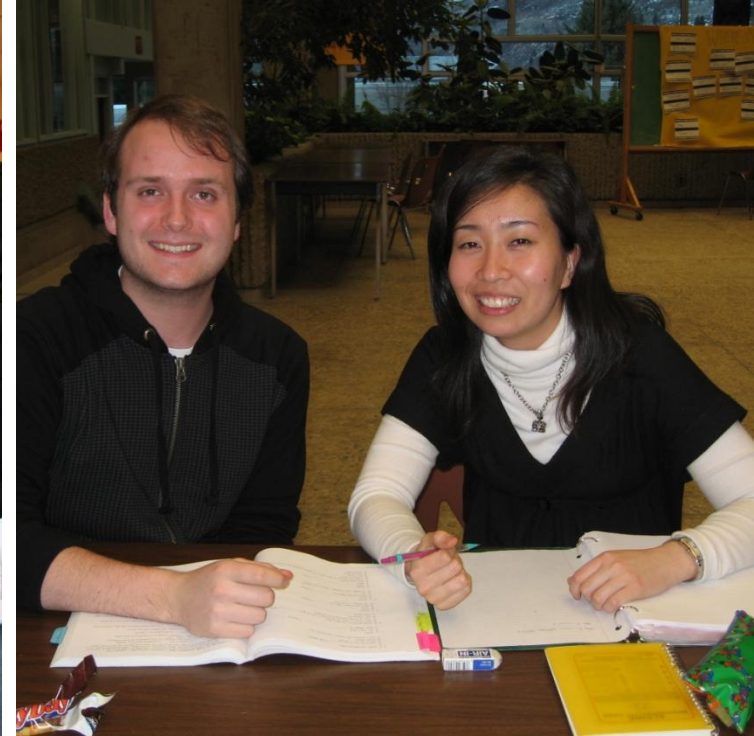

# CO-OP vs PRACTICUM

- A **practicum** is a **REQUIRED** part of a program (must finish)

Length	Fall Semester	Winter Semester	May to October
Year 1	Study	Study	5 month Practicum
Year 2	Study	Study	April Graduation

- A **practicum** MAY be **paid or unpaid**
- A **practicum** is sometimes called a **WORK TERM**
- A **co-op** is an **OPTIONAL** part of a program
- A **co-op** is **PAID** work experience in your field of study
- A **co-op** placement is not guaranteed and enrolment in the program is often based on grades and instructor recommendations

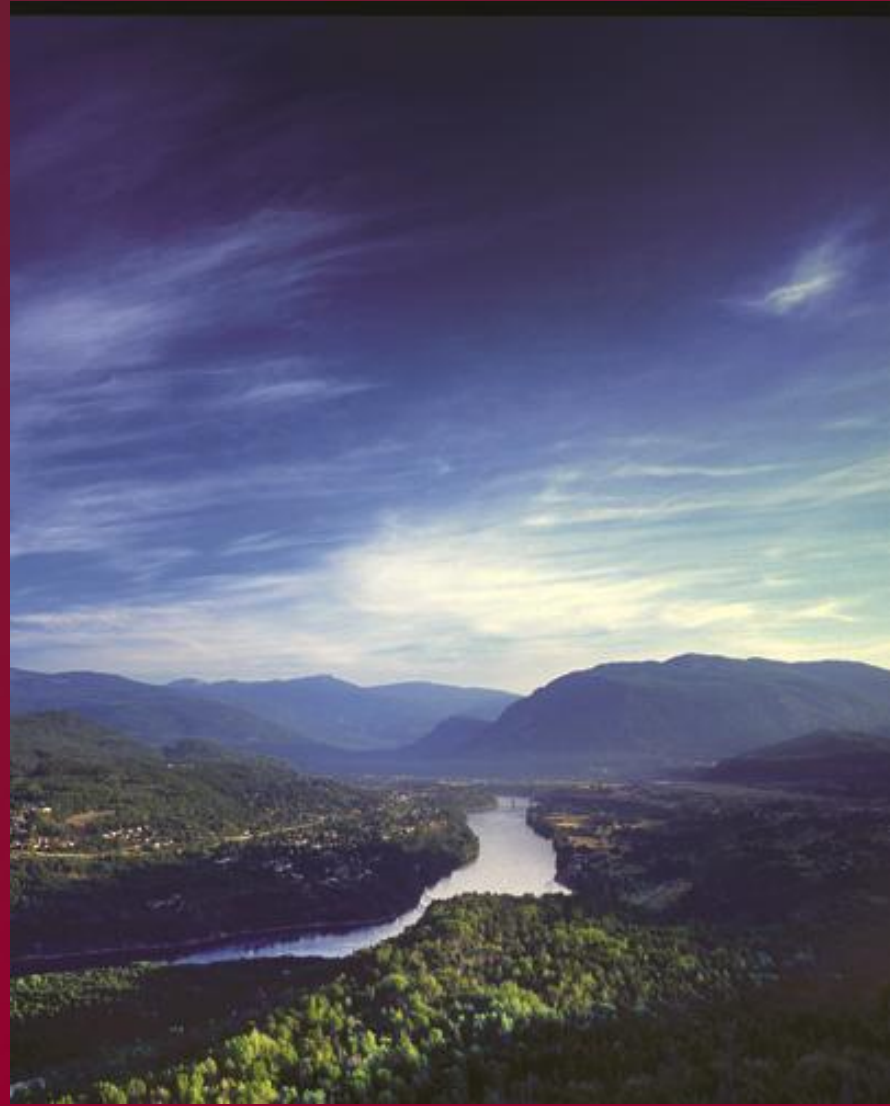

Co-op receive credit on transcripts and require final reports and regular online submissions

Students who are accepted into the co-op get assistance with:

- Resume's and job skills
- Interview preparation and coaching
- Assistance with job search and selection
- Follow up and support during co-op
