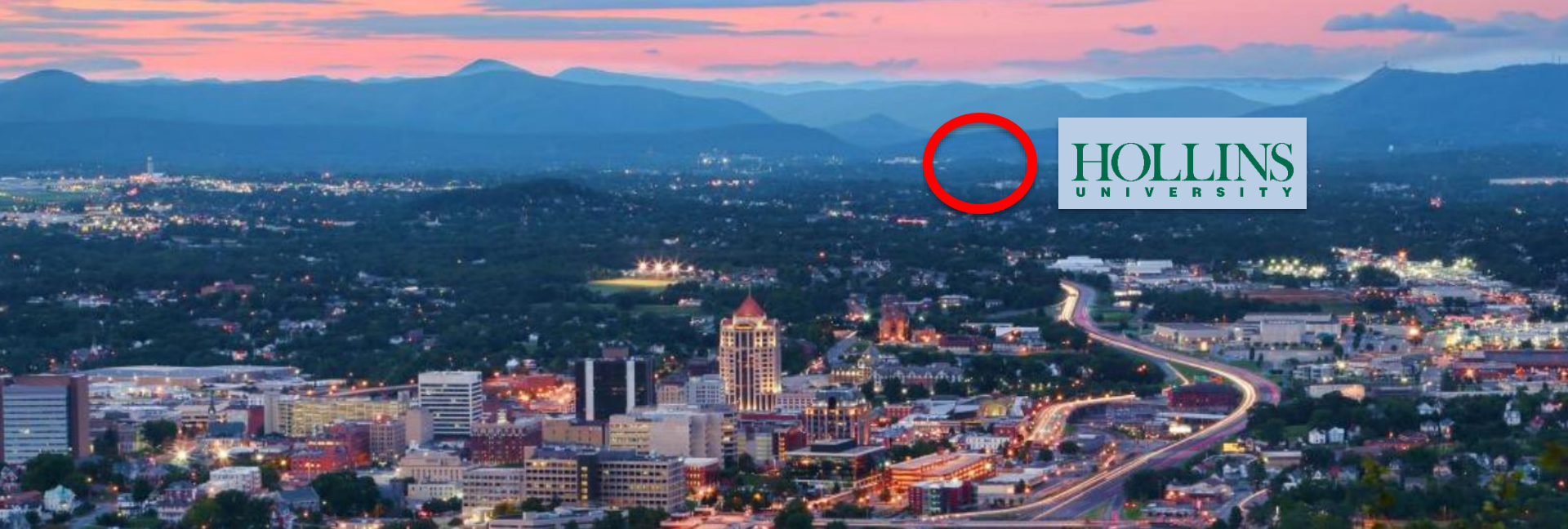
Population of region: 320,000

## Total Indirect Cost

### Required indirect costs

*Indirect costs are not paid to the university and can vary by student.*

# Scholarships

## ❖ **Academic Merit Scholarship**

- ❖ All admitted international students are eligible
- ❖ Begins at **\$23,000USD**

## ❖ **International Friendship Award**

- ❖ On average looking for students to pay \$23,000USD towards direct cost

## ❖ **#YouAreWelcomeHere Scholarship**

- ❖ \$15,000USD
- ❖ Additional application
- ❖ Due January 1

## ❖ **Global Commitment Scholarship**

- ❖ Full-tuition (\$39,360USD)
- ❖ Additional application
- ❖ Due March 1



# Admission Requirements

It is **free** to apply using **commonapp.com**

To apply, we require:

- Transcript
- SAT and/or ACT scores required
- Letter of recommendation or secondary school report
- TOEFL or IELTS – only for non-native English speakers
  - 6.5 or higher on IELTS, 80 on internet-based TOEFL
  - Can be waived if language of instruction is English, over 610 EBR on SAT or over 26 on English section of ACT





# Admission Requirements

TOEFL / IETLS can be waived if:

- English is language of instruction for three years or more
- Achieves over 610 on EBR section of SAT or
- Achieves over 26 on English section of ACT



# For I-20

Our preference is to receive the following documents at the time of application to assist in providing I-20 if admitted.

- Certificate of Finances (CoF)
- Bank Statement
- Copy of page in passport which includes photo
- Letter of financial support if CoF isn't signed



# Admitted profile

- GPA of 3.0+
- SAT of 1,000+
- ACT of 21+

Higher scores = **more scholarship!**
