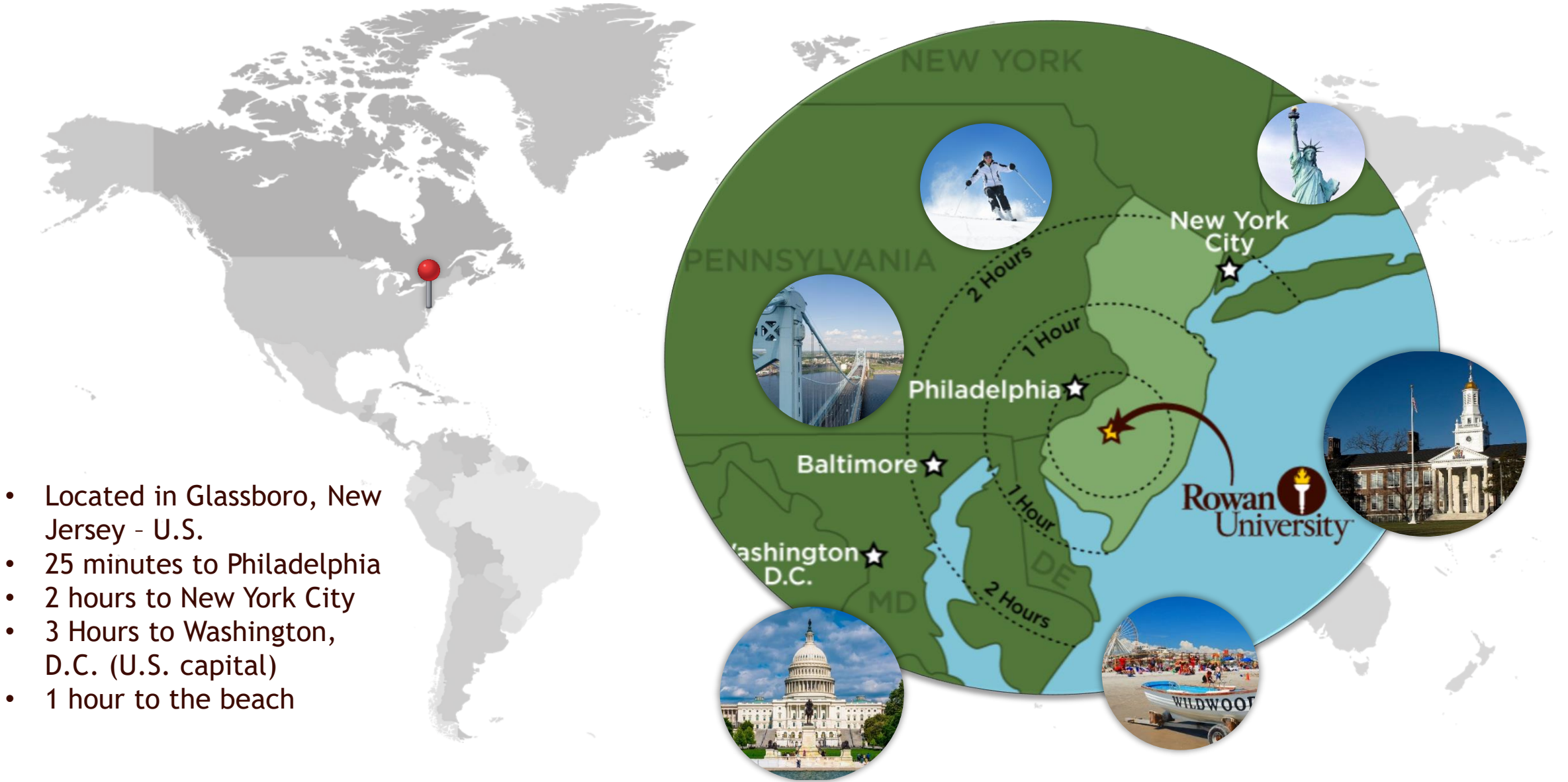

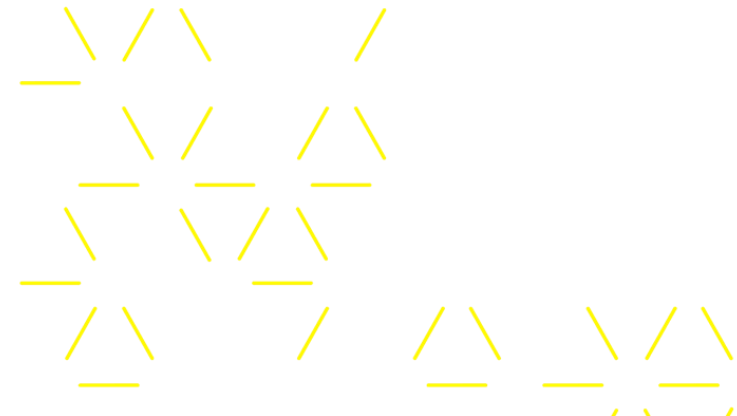

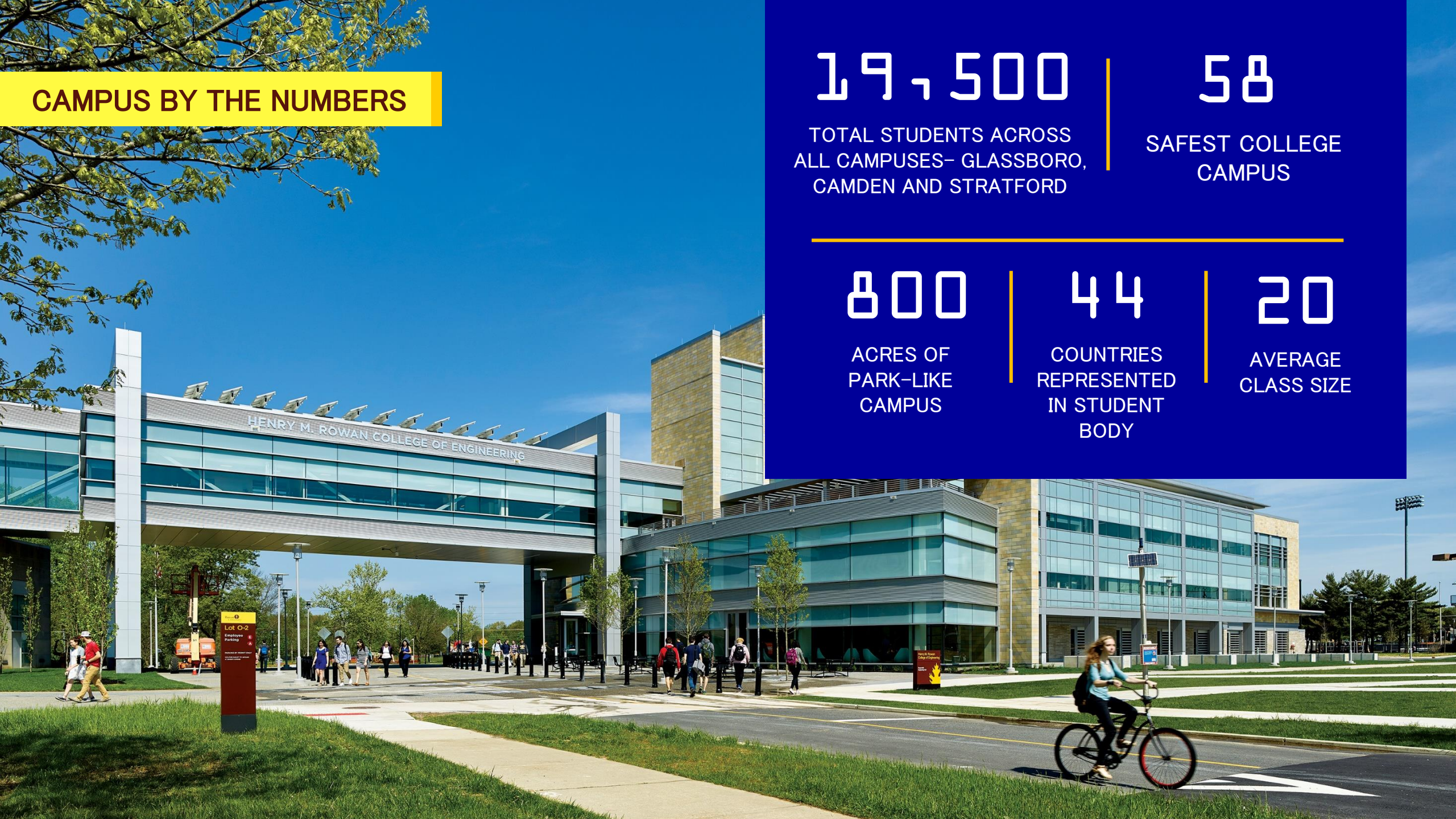

DUOLINGO

- Minimum score of 95 for full admission
- Scanned copy of score report accepted

TOEFL

- Minimum score of 70 for full admission
- Score must be sent through ETS (Rowan's code is 2515)

IELTS

- Minimum score 6.0 overall for full admission
- Scanned copy of score report accepted

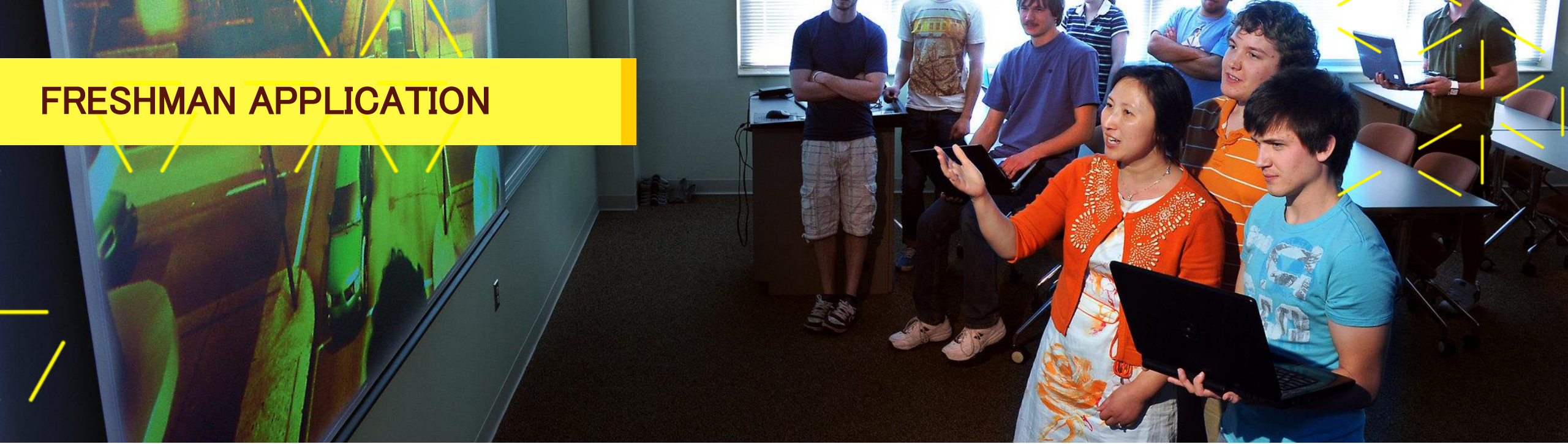
PTE

- Minimum score 50 overall for full admission
- Scanned copy of score report accepted

Also accepted:

- Successful completion of Rowan's English Language Program (ELP) Level 5 with a minimum GPA score of 3.0
- SAT/ACT
- Successful completion of ELS – Level 112
- A minimum grade of 5 or higher in International Baccalaureate (IB) English-A course or a minimum grade of 6 or higher in International Baccalaureate (IB) English-B course

COMMON APPLICATION

- Proof of language proficiency
- Scanned unofficial copy of high school transcripts
- For Engineering ONLY: official SAT or ACT scores
- For Performing or Creative Arts ONLY (art, music, theater, dance): audition or portfolio review

REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 12 college credits
- Applicants with more than 24 college credits do NOT need to submit high school transcripts
- Minimum 2.0 CGPA
 - For Engineering and Business ONLY: separate course and cumulative GPA requirements.
- Foreign Credential Evaluation
- Proof of language proficiency
