Honors Program

The Honors Program is designed to give a limited number of high-achieving students the opportunity to study in greater depth than is possible in the regular degree programs. All accepted Honors students will receive a half-tuition scholarship.* Students must be full-time enrolled and maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA each award period to retain their scholarship. Honors program is for full time continuous enrollment (three semesters per year)

* International students who receive the Honors Scholarship are not eligible for any other institutional aid. Cost of books, supplies, housing, and graduation fees not included.



Four-year Combined B.B.A./M.B.A. Option

This special program allows highachieving students to complete both a Bachelor's and Master's degree in as few as four calendar years, assuming full-time enrollment in three semesters per year.*

Undergraduate Admissions Requirements

Required Documents:

- A completed Berkeley International Application Form
- A completed Scholarship Application Form (if applicable)
- Official secondary or post-secondary transcripts of academic grades (translated into English) and proof of graduation
- Proof of English language proficiency:

TOEFL – score of 500 PBT, 61 IBT
IELTS – score of 5.5 or higher
English Language School Certificate of approved level

Other English Language tests and courses accepted

Acceptance Confirmation to Issue Acceptance Packet with I-20:

- Official document of financial support demonstrating a minimum of \$39,000 (U.S.) in available funds
- Copy of Passport
- \$100 (U.S.) international processing fee
- \$300 (U.S.) Refundable Tuition Deposit*
- \$400 (U.S.) Residence Deposit* (For White Plains residents)

This deposit will be refunded if written notice of cancellation is received at least 60 days prior to the starting date of the term for which the student has been accepted, or if the student is refused admission to the college, or if the student visa. In the event of a visa denial, written proof of the denial from the U.S. Embassy and return of the I-20 Certificate are required to receive the refund.

Residence facilities should be reserved well in advance. A \$400 room deposit is required for the White Plains residence facilities. Of this amount, \$200 is credited toward the final term's rent; the remaining \$200 is held as a deposit until the student has checked out of the room satisfactorily. The refund policy for the residence deposit is the same as the tuition deposit listed above.



^{*} Deposits/I-20 Certificates and Refund Policy: A \$300 (U.S.) tuition deposit reserves a place at Berkeley and will be applied to tuition. The I-20 Certificate will not be sent until the tuition deposit and all required academic and financial documents are received.



Residence facilities should be reserved well in advance. A \$400 room deposit is required for the White Plains residence facilities. Financial Aid

Tuition Freeze

Educational costs are an important consideration for students selecting a college. For that reason, Berkeley College protects eligible students from increases in full-time tuition rates through the Tuition Freeze Program. To be eligible, students must be enrolled full-time in degree programs for two consecutive semesters, beginning with their first semester at the College. Eligible students' full-time tuition rates stay the same as long as the students remain continuously enrolled in degree programs with no more than one semester of absence.

Scholarships

International scholarships are available to students who qualify. Scholarship applications must be received with admissions applications.

Home Country Financial Aid

Many countries offer financial assistance to students studying in the United States. We encourage students to contact their government offices.





Transfer Credits

Berkeley will accept transfer credits for courses that are deemed applicable by the College to a student's program at Berkeley in which the student earned a minimum grade of C. For a complete review of transfer credits, students should submit their transcripts along with their application documents. All documents must be translated into English. International Baccalaureate (IB) and Global Assessment Certificate (GAC) credits are eligible for review.

Visa

We assist students in obtaining the appropriate visas to study in the United States. In general, many students come to the United States with an F-1 visa. If applying for the F-1 visa, we will provide students with the I-20 document after acceptance.

- Official post-secondary/undergraduate transcripts (translated into English) and proof of graduation
- Two letters of recommendation
- Resume (Indicate any work experience)
- Personal Statement
- Proof of English language proficiency:

TOEFL – score of 80 IBT IELTS – score of 6.5 for M.B.A.)

Acceptance Confirmation to Issue Acceptance Packet with I-20:

- Official document of financial support demonstrating a minimum of \$39,000 (U.S.) in available funds
- Copy of Passport
- \$100 (U.S.) international processing fee
- \$300 (U.S.) Refundable Tuition Deposit*

This deposit will be refunded if written notice of cancellation is received at least 60 days prior to the starting date of the term for which the student has been accepted, or if the student is refused admission to the college, or if the student is denied a student visa. In the event of a visa denial, written proof of the denial from the U.S. Embassy and return of the I-20 Certificate are required to receive the refund.
